Mdina & Rabat Half-Day Experience



Step through the majestic Mdina Gate and into a world where time stands still. In the hushed streets of the "Silent City," your private curator will guide you past noble palaces, hidden courtyards, and sunlit piazzas, sharing tales of knights, noble families, and the city's layered past. Wander through the elegantly preserved Domvs Romana before your way to the heart of Rabat. Here, you will walk to St Paul's Square, once enclosed by the walls of the Roman town of Melite, and continue past the serene Santu Spirtu, taking in its historic surroundings. Your journey takes you back to Mdina, at the stately Vilhena Palace, where a sommelier awaits to present a hand-picked selection of fine Maltese wines paired with artisanal platters, savoured in an intimate setting reserved solely for you.

Begin your journey with the rare privilege of a private opening at Tas-Silġ in Marsaxlokk, an ancient sanctuary overlooking the sea. Here, a curator will reveal the sacred rituals and maritime legends of the Phoenician period as you sip a welcome drink and take in the timeless surroundings. Enjoy an elegantly presented wine and platter experience or indulge in a Phoenician-inspired luxury picnic among the site's historic stones. Continue to the National Museum of Archaeology, located in Valletta, for an intimate curator-led viewing of Malta's most treasured artefacts, including exclusive access to rarely seen pieces from the reserve collection.

Your day begins with an exclusive opening of Tas-Silġ in Marsaxlokk, where the sea breeze carries whispers of Phoenician mariners and ancient worshippers. Guided by your curator, you'll trace the site's sacred past before journeying to the National Museum of Archaeology in Valletta, for an intimate encounter with Malta's Neolithic and Phoenician treasures. Here, the reserve collection opens for your private exploration, offering the rare chance to handle museum objects.

Pause for a refined Taste History lunch or a curated wine tasting experience, either in the dignified setting of the National Museum of Archaeology Gran Salon's adjoining room, or within the elegant surroundings of the Domvs Romana. After exploring this Roman townhouse, with its intricate mosaics reflecting the artistry and grandeur of the empire, the journey concludes at Abbatija tad-Dejr in Rabat; a tranquil, rarely accessible site where time appears to stand still.

Streets of Power & Splendour

Valletta Half-Day Experience



Grand Master's Palace



Step through Valletta's grand City Gate and into a capital where every square, palace, and garden breathe history. Begin with a curated walk past the Royal Opera House, De Valette's monument, and the graceful façades of the churches of St Catherine and Our Lady of Victory. Stand before the commanding Auberge de Castille, a symbol of knightly power, before enjoying sweeping harbour views from the Barrakka Gardens.

Inside St John's Co-Cathedral, the golden splendour of Baroque artistry and Caravaggio paintings surround you, while the Grand Master's Palace or the National Museum of Archaeology open their doors for a private exploration. Your journey concludes in a setting steeped in history, where a sommelier will present fine local wines paired with artisanal platters, each morsel accompanied by the stories that shaped Malta's capital.







Fortress Under Siege



WWII Valletta Half-Day Experience

Start at Fort St Elmo, where the first bombs fell on Malta during the Second World War. As you explore its bastions and Harbour Fire Command posts, immersive VR technology transports you to the very moments of wartime defence. A curator-led tour of the museum reveals rare artefacts and micro-exhibits, offering insight into Malta's resilience.

From the Upper Barrakka Gardens, gaze towards Fort St Angelo and the waters where HMS Illustrious came under attack, as your guide recounts the battles that raged in the Grand Harbour. Listen to the stories of the Lascaris War Rooms and uncover the strategic genius that safeguarded the island. Your tour concludes with a refined wine and platter experience back at Fort St Elmo, a moment of calm and elegance to mull over all those past events steeped in courage and history.

A Nation at War

WWII Valletta Full-Day Experience



Your journey into Malta's wartime past begins beneath the streets of the capital at Underground Valletta, where these shelters once safeguarded thousands. Here, the echoes of history are heightened by a private acoustic performance, a cellist or violinist playing within the atmospheric cistern.

At Fort St Elmo, an augmented reality experience brings gun emplacements and fire commands to life before your eyes, followed by a curator's private tour of the fort's WWII galleries. Enjoy a wine-paired platter contextualised with stories of rationing and resilience, then continue to the Upper Barrakka Gardens for sweeping views over the Grand Harbour as your guide recounts Operation Pedestal, Operation Husky, and the defence of the island.

Crossing to the other side of the Valletta peninsula, at St Michael's Bastion, one can still see the historic gun emplacements overlooking Marsamxett Harbour and the imposing Fort Emanuel, also known as HMS Phoenicia. This site once hosted the base of the 10th Submarine Flotilla, whose daring missions intercepted Axis supply lines to North Africa.

The Three Cities Revealed

Senglea, Cospicua & Vittoriosa Half-Day Experience



Start on the Senglea Gardjola Bastions, where a chilled glass of prosecco accompanies the views across the Grand Harbour. Stroll past historic façades and quiet churches, stopping at sites linked to Malta's greatest siege and its storied maritime past. In Cospicua, your private guide leads you through winding streets and piazzas steeped in the heritage of dockyards and devotion.

You will cross into Vittoriosa via the Couvre Porte, then walk through the Collacchio, once the exclusive quarter of the Knights, to view the exterior of the Benedictine church before continuing to the main square. Your journey ends with an exclusive access to the Inquisitor's Palace, where a sommelier awaits to present fine wines and artisanal platters within a setting rich in intrigue and history.

Fort St Angelo



Arrive at Couvre Porte for a glass of chilled prosecco before setting off on a private walking route that explores the city's formidable defences. Traverse the French Curtain, pause at the Posts of Castille and Germany, and down through the Infirmary Sally Port before reaching the dramatic ditch of Fort St Angelo.

Within the fort, your curator leads you through the Upper Areas and Knights' Quarters, revealing stories of sieges, strategy, and survival. A pop-up curated exhibit offers access to museum objects seldom on display. Conclude high above the harbour with an elegant wine and platter experience, the golden light of late afternoon casting a glow over the stone ramparts.

Full-Day Gozo Experience



Depart Malta for a day of exploration on its sister island. At Ġgantija, enjoy early private access before the site opens to the public, with the option of a champagne breakfast or picnic brunch among ancient olive groves. Continue to Dwejra for a private boat ride through the Inland Sea, accompanied by champagne on board.

Visit the serene Ta' Pinu Sanctuary before going to the Ġgantija for a Taste History lunch within the Gran Castello Historic House, each course inspired by Gozo's layered past. Later, walk the salt pans of Żebbuġ, before pausing for coffee in the coastal charm of Marsalforn.
